We have been also the national co-host of Weinstein International Foundation International Mediation Writing Competition since 2021.



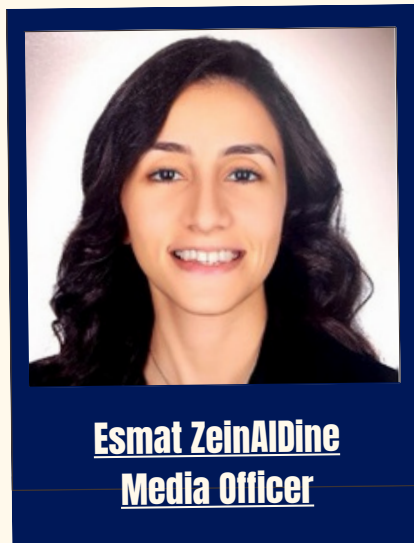

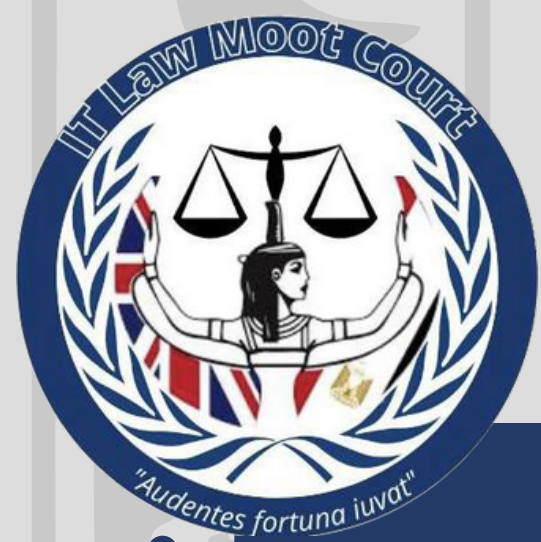

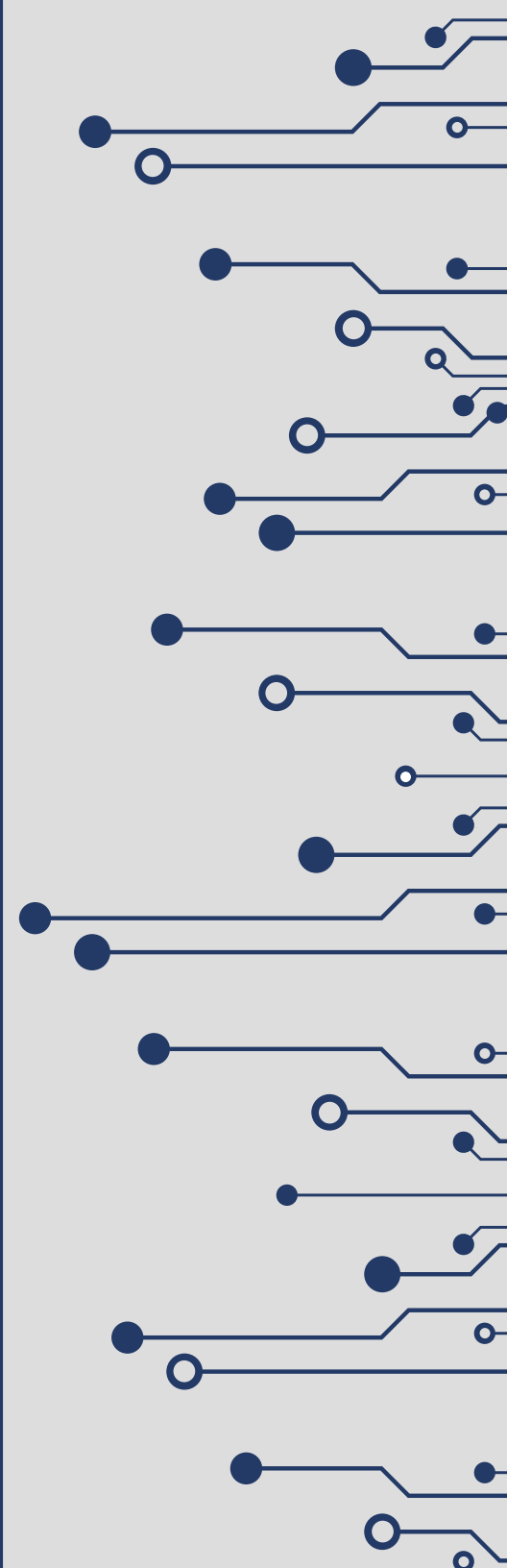
THE IT LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION IS AN ANNUAL EVENT, ORGANIZED BY THE FACULTY OF LAW THE BRITISH UNIVERSITY IN EGYPT. THIS EVENT BRINGS TOGETHER LAW STUDENTS, ACADEMICS, PRACTITIONERS AND JUDGES TO ARGUE A HYPOTHETICAL CASE AND SHARE EXPERTISE IN THE FIELD OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY LAW AND ITS INTERSECTION WITH DIFFERENT LAWS. THIS YEAR, THE COMPETITION WILL TACKLE ISSUES RELATING TO CYBERSECURITY AND SOCIAL MEDIA LIABILITY DURING TIME OF CONFLICTS.

THE COMPETITION HAS BEEN HELD REGULARLY SINCE 2020 AND HAS BEEN SERVED ON ALL THE THREE LEVELS: INTERNAL, NATIONAL, AND REGIONAL. THIS YEAR WE INVITE THE MOST DISTINGUISHED PARTICIPANTS FROM MIDDLE EASTERN AND AFRICAN UNIVERSITIES. THE OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION ARE TO EDUCATE FUTURE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS AND ACADEMICS FROM ACROSS THE REGION REGARDING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY LAW; TO PROVIDE A FORUM FOR CULTURAL EXCHANGE AND NETWORKING BETWEEN AFRICAN AND MIDDLE EASTERN LAW FACULTIES, LAWYERS, AND ACADEMICS; AND TO PROMOTE THE ROLE OF LAW AND LEGAL INSTITUTIONS IN RESOLVING CONFLICTS.
